
Use this bookmark as a way to remember to pray for:

To make your bookmark

Print and cut out the bookmark (if possible on card). Fold in half and stick the two sides together.

If you want to, you can add a knotted 'tail'. Punch through a hole marked at the bottom. Then take a length of narrow ribbon, string, or wool, thread it through and tie 5 knots spaced apart along its length. As you pray you may wish to feel each knot - one for each of the five you are praying for.
