CORONAVIRUS UPDATE:

- Public Worship will resumed last Sunday (5 July) at St John's, with specific guidelines:
 - Washing of hands/use of hand sanitiser is required on entry and exit.
 - \circ $\;$ Social Distancing of 2m to be maintained where possible.
 - Face coverings may be worn but are not mandatory.
 - Households/bubbles may sit together, otherwise distancing to be observed. Labelled seating to help.
 - Up to 50 people may be attend each Service in church on a first come, first served basis. Worshippers
 will be asked for contact details on arrival for test and trace, should this be necessary.
 - Although there will be music during the service, we will not be singing.
 - Communion will be administered in one kind (sharing of the Common Cup still suspended). Please follow the directions of the Sidespeople.
 - Worshippers are requested to limiting their touch of unnecessary surfaces.
 - Orders of Service and other worship resources will be available for use and are to be taken home.
 - This is not a return to normal but the next step to returning to normal. Things will look and feel slightly different.
 - Junior Church remains suspended and the Children's Room and Activity bags will be out of use.

Financial offerings will be via the Plate stationed at the back of church, not passed between each other.
 It will be a joy to welcome as many as are able to return to Public Worship but we acknowledge this will not be possible for everyone. We are making the church was safe as we can for you to return but if you are shielding please observe Government guidance. This is your Church and you will be always welcome here.

- For those unable to physically join the Parish Eucharist at 10.00am it will be streamed on our website at 6.00pm. The usual Worship resources remain available on our Website <u>www.stjohnsboxmoor.org.uk</u>
- Phased return to Public Worship means no Public Worship at St Francis' or St Stephen's for the time being. We have moved the Parish Eucharist to 10.00am to help accommodate those who prefer a later service time.
- Holy Communion will also be offered on Wednesday mornings at 10.00am at St John's. This will be followed by the Zoom Coffee Morning at 11.00am.
- This practice has been, and will continue to be reviewed as we develop the best practice we can offer. A Booking system might be introduced if we are unable to accommodate everyone, or a 3rd service.
- St John's and St Francis' are **OPEN** for **PRIVATE PRAYER** as follows:
 - St John's is open for Private Prayer 9.30am-5.00pm every day (Saturdays 10.30am-5.30pm)
 - St Francis' will be open on Wednesdays and Sundays 3.00-5.00pm

Please follow the guidance in church regarding distancing. Prayer resources will be available.

- Please keep praying for our Key Workers, each other, and all those infected and affected by this horrible virus.
- Please keep praying for, and phoning/writing to, each other and helping where there is need, especially those unable to join us physically for Worship.
