#### **CORONAVIRUS UPDATE:**

- Tier 2 Restrictions mean:
  - Public Worship can resume provided the following are observed:
    - No mingling/socialising in church with those outside your household/bubble
    - Face covers to be worn throughout services
    - Social distancing to be observed and regular hand sanitising
    - Track & Trace details will be sought on arrival
    - Ventilation is considered (St John's and St Francis' have high ceilings so doors and windows can now be closed)
    - Maximum attendance for non-ticketed services will remain at 65 people.
    - Indoor congregational singing remains prohibited
- St Stephen's will remain closed until we drop to Tier 1 or below. It is harder to maintain social distancing and no socialising in that context.
- St John's is open for Private Prayer 9.30am-5.30pm every day (Saturdays 10.30am-5.00pm). Please follow the guidance in church regarding distancing. Prayer resources will be available.
- Funerals can also be conducted in church.
