COVID NOTICES: Current measures in this Parish, in line with Government regulations:

The following measures are in operation in order to help maintain confidence in coming to Church to worship:

- Within Church:
 - o **Face Coverings are to be worn in all our buildings.** The exceptions are:
 - o The choir who will test before singing; those leading or reading at service
 - Children under 12, or people who are exempt
 - When refreshments are being taken.
 - o Social Distancing to be maintained -One pew (over 1 metre) to remain empty between different bubbles
 - o Congregational Singing is still permitted but whilst wearing a mask.
 - o Use of hand sanitiser stations is still encouraged.
 - o Track & Trace to remain in place we recommend signing-in rather than using the App.
 - Communion will continue to be given in one kind (Bread) please be directed by the sidespeople. Your ministers will still wear a face covering when distributing Communion.
 - o Refreshments will no-longer be offered after the Parish Eucharist. They will continue at smaller services.
