COVID NOTICES – UPDATE –Sunday 23 January:

The Government has announced that from next Thursday face coverings and other precautions are not mandatory. Therefore for this week:

• in line with Government regulations:

- **Face Coverings are to be worn in all our buildings.** The exceptions are:
 - The choir who will test before singing; those leading or reading at service
 - \circ Children under 12, or people who are exempt
- When refreshments are being taken.
- Social Distancing to be maintained –One pew (over 1 metre) to remain empty between different bubbles
- Congregational Singing is still permitted but whilst wearing a mask.
- Use of hand sanitiser stations is still encouraged.
- Track & Trace to remain in place we recommend signing-in rather than using the App.
- Communion will continue to be given in one kind (Bread) please be directed by the sidespeople. Your ministers will still wear a face covering when distributing Communion.
- Refreshments will no-longer be offered after the Parish Eucharist. They will continue at smaller services

From Next Sunday:

All precautions to remain in place <u>EXCEPT</u> face coverings will now only be required when moving around the building. ie when seated, singing, or taking refreshments no masks required.

LIVE STREAMING - UPDATE: The technology is now up and running for us to live stream services on our website. All the equipment is working which means we should be able to live stream the Parish Eucharist every week. However, our internet connection is proving unreliable. Mobile usage in our area (especially at the Sports Centre) on a Sunday morning is higher than anticipated. We are trying various options to overcome this. We will continue to try to live stream with the back-up option of recording the stream direct (before it goes to YouTube) and then uploading this later in the day if the connection at church remains a problem. This is not ideal but, as I understand it, a fairly typical teething problem. (which is what we happened for the last two weeks.)
