COVID NOTICES – UPDATE –Sunday 30 January:

The Government has announced that face coverings and other precautions are not mandatory. However, to care for one another we ask:

- <u>Face Coverings to be worn in crowded areas.</u> Please consider wearing one whilst moving around, especially when receiving Communion.
- Social Distancing to be maintained –One pew (over 1 metre) to remain empty between different bubbles
- Congregational Singing is back to normal you might like to wear a mask but you don't have to.
- Use of hand sanitiser stations is still encouraged.
- Track & Trace to remain in place we recommend signing-in rather than using the App.
- Communion will continue to be given in one kind (Bread) please be directed by the sidespeople. Your ministers will still wear a face covering when distributing Communion.
- Refreshments will no-longer be offered after the Parish Eucharist. They will continue at smaller services

<u>ALTAR FLOWERS</u>: The Altar flowers this week have been sponsored and arranged by Jean Frith for 'Memories of Family Birthdays past and present'.

LIVE STREAMING - UPDATE: The technology is now up and running for us to live stream services on our website. All the equipment is working which means we should be able to live stream the Parish Eucharist every week. However, our internet connection is proving unreliable. Mobile usage in our area (especially at the Sports Centre) on a Sunday morning is higher than anticipated. We are trying various options to overcome this. We will continue to try to live stream with the back-up option of recording the stream direct (before it goes to YouTube) and then uploading this later in the day if the connection at church remains a problem. This is not ideal but, as I understand it, a fairly typical teething problem. Our services will be available at: <u>www.stjohnsboxmoor.org.uk/live-streamed-services</u> - we apologise in advance if our internet connection fails! (It worked properly last week!)

<u>LIVE STREAMING – VISIBILITY IN SERVICES</u>: There are various issues concerning Safeguarding and GDPR which mean we need your permission for you to appear on screen – especially if you are a minor. A plan of where you can sit without being seen on camera is being drawn up; permission is being sought from families for children to be on camera; camera angles are being planned and programmed for various parts of the service to limit exposure. Thank you for your cooperation.

TREES FOR THE QUEEN'S PLATINUM JUBILEE: The PCC has decided to plant two trees in the churchyard to mark The Queen's Platinum Jubilee. We have chosen two smaller varieties as there are already several mature trees in the churchyard. We have chosen an acer bush for the changing colour throughout the year and a lilac tree for the blossom and the scent. The lilac blossom would be the colour shade of purple to match the Jubilee colour. If any member of the parish would like to contribute £1 towards the project for two trees and a commemorative plaque Marian Davis or Lorraine loannou would be pleased to receive your contribution.
