## **COVID NOTICES – UPDATED – Sunday 27 February:**

The Government has announced the rescinding of all legal restrictions put in place to curb the pandemic However, to care for one another we ask:

- Please consider wearing a face covering whilst moving around, especially when receiving Communion, or in crowded areas.
- Social Distancing will be maintained for the foreseeable future –One pew (over 1 metre) to remain empty between different bubbles
- Congregational Singing is back to normal you might like to wear a mask but you don't have to.
- Use of hand sanitiser stations is still encouraged.
- Communion will continue to be given in one kind (Bread) please be directed by the sidespeople. Your ministers will still wear a face covering when distributing Communion.
- Refreshments will be offered once more at all the main Sunday services.

**ASH WEDNESDAY:** This Week - You are invited to begin the holy season of Lent by receiving in ash the sign of the cross, calling to mind our mortality and need to be forgiven. Service times are 10.00am and 8.00pm at St John's.

<u>LENT COURSE 2022: THE JOY OF THE GOSPEL</u> During Lockdown we might have lost some of our capacity for joy, and most likely some of our willingness to speak to people – known or unknown. The Christian Faith requires that we and all the baptised should *Proclaim the Gospel*. This should be done with joy and confidence. To help us re-engage with this task, to grow our confidence, to affirm one another, and recommit to our faith, you are invited to our Lent Course. <u>LIVE STREAMING – VISIBILITY IN SERVICES:</u> There are various issues concerning Safeguarding and GDPR which mean we need your permission for you to appear on screen – especially if you are a minor. A plan of where you can sit without being seen on camera is being drawn up; permission is being sought from families for children to be on camera; camera angles are being planned and programmed for various parts of the service to limit exposure. Thank you for your cooperation.

TREES FOR THE QUEEN'S PLATINUM JUBILEE: The PCC has decided to plant two trees in the churchyard to mark The Queen's Platinum Jubilee. We have chosen two smaller varieties as there are already several mature trees in the churchyard. We have chosen an acer bush for the changing colour throughout the year and a lilac tree for the blossom and the scent. The lilac blossom would be the colour shade of purple to match the Jubilee colour. If any member of the parish would like to contribute £1 towards the project for two trees and a commemorative plaque Marian Davis or Lorraine loannou would be pleased to receive your contribution.
