COVID UPDATE:

- From this Thursday we will be **re-introducing the chalice** within the parish. Receiving communion in both kinds is not compulsory (as our recent practice has shown). If you would like to receive the chalice the offer is there. If you would prefer not to receive from the common cup then simply receive the host and walk back to your places. It is an entirely personal decision. The way in which communion has recently been administered will need to be slightly altered to accommodate this return to normal practice, but this will be explained during the service. Your ministers will no-longer be required to wear face coverings to distribute the Sacrament.
- Mandatory Social Distancing has ceased, however, please be mindful when choosing somewhere to sit as some
 may still prefer to keep at a respectable distance and/or wear a face covering. If you would like some space
 no-one will be offended if you say so.
- The physical sharing of the Peace remains suspended.
