COVID GUIDANCE:

- The Chalice: Receiving communion in both kinds is not compulsory (as our recent practice has shown). If you
 would like to receive the chalice the offer is there. If you would prefer not to receive from the common cup
 then simply receive the host and walk back to your places. It is an entirely personal decision.
- Intincting/dipping your wafer into the wine is not permitted.
