<u>LIVE STREAMING – THIS WEEK:</u> The Parish Eucharist at 10.00am will be live streamed this week. **<u>DURING LENT</u>**: You are invited to observe 5 minutes quiet before the Parish Eucharist. This will be signalled by the organist playing something. Use this time to enter more fully into God's presence.

<u>PASSIONTIDE SERVICE:</u> Sunday 17 March, 6.30pm, St John's. By way of encouraging our thinking and devotions on our Lord's suffering and death on the cross for our redemption our choir will lead us in a musical devotion: *The Saviour* by William Lloyd Webber. This is a companion work to *The Crucifixion* and *Olivet to Calvary* and takes us through the events and moments of Jesus' last hours. All welcome to join this moving service. <u>YOUR CHURCH NEEDS YOU:</u> As we approach Holy Week and Easter we will need help with some of our services. ### **PALM SUNDAY:**

- Morning: Our Parish Eucharist begins at Boxmoor Playhouse at 10.00am. We will then process to St John's mirroring Jesus's procession into Jerusalem on a donkey waving our palms. This is a great opportunity to witness to our faith. The Eucharist then proceeds as normal.
- **Evening:** To re-enforce the beginning of Holy Week there will be a special service of Solemn Evensong & Benediction at 6.30pm at St Francis, Hammerfield. Everyone is welcome.

<u>HOLY WEEK & EASTER SERVICES:</u> Please see our poster/Easter Cards for details of all our services. It is a very moving week and you are warmly invited to come to all our services. Particular highlights include the **Maundy Thursday Eucharist and Watch, Good Friday's Hour at the Cross, Holy Saturday's Vigil, and Easter Sunday.** There will also be a Service of Prayers for Healing. This service is both to pray for people who have asked for our prayers and, if you would, to receive the ministry of anointing and laying on of hands. Please add names to be prayed for on the list at the back of St John's.

<u>PASSIONTIDE ARRAY:</u> In union with the Church universal our crosses, statues, and artwork have been veiled for the final two weeks of Lent. This deprivation is intended to encourage us to think about Christ's atoning sacrifice on the cross more deeply.
